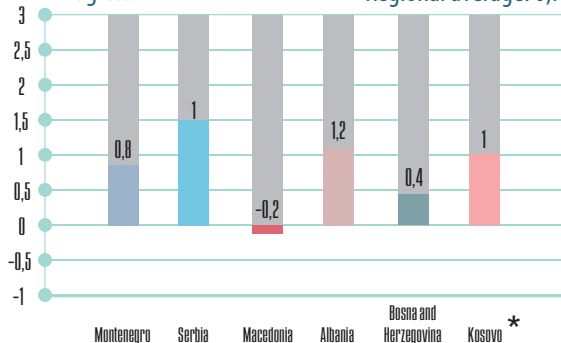

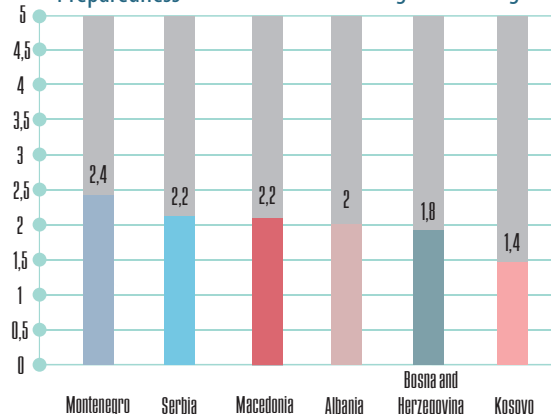

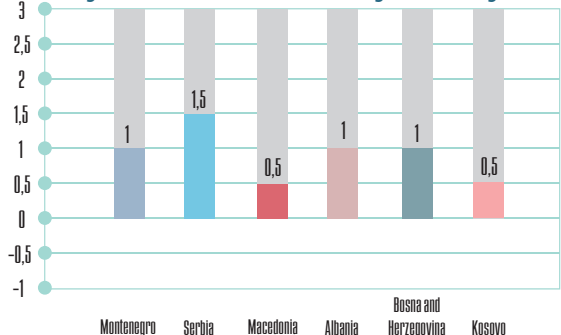
Preparedness² Regional average: 2



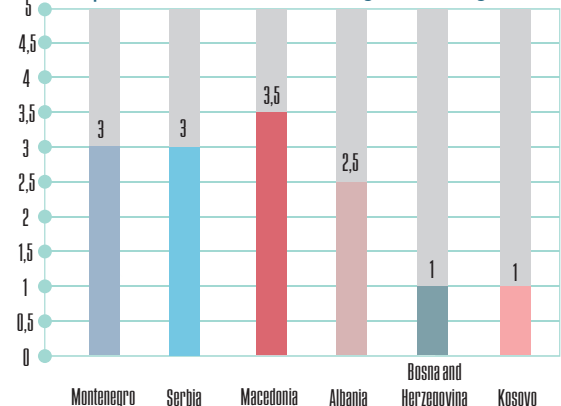

Progress Regional average: 0,91

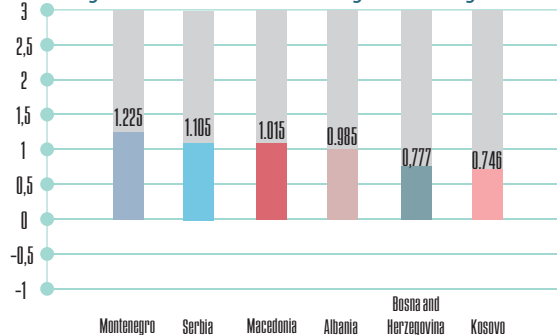


Preparedness Regional average: 2,333



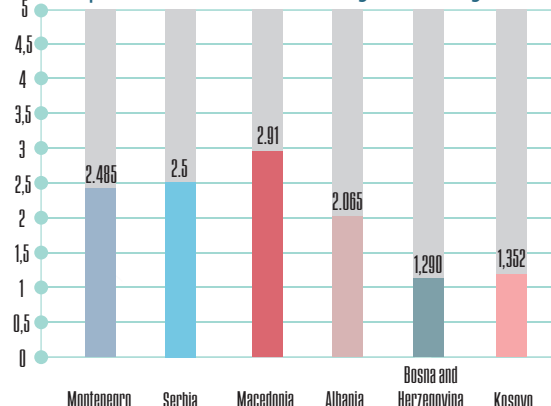
ABILITY TO ASSUME THE OBLIGATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP/EUROPEAN STANDARDS
